Purpose of Status Conference

Pursuant to section 1208 of the Commission's regulations, a Committee may hold a conference with the parties and any other persons interested in the proceeding for the purpose formulating the issues or any other matters as may expedite the orderly conduct of the proceedings.

Background

On November 20, 2012, AES Southland, LLC (AES) submitted an Application for Certification (AFC) to the California Energy Commission seeking permission to construct and operate a power generation facility, the Redondo Beach Energy Project (RBEP), located at 1100 North Harbor Drive, in the City of Redondo Beach, Los Angeles County. The site is southeast of the intersection of North Harbor Drive and Herondo Street. The project would be located entirely within the footprint of the existing AES Redondo Beach Generating Station, an operating power plant.

Energy Commission staff published the Preliminary Staff Assessment on July 28, 2014. Shortly before the PSA was published, the Committee learned that AES had submitted an initiative petition to the city of Redondo Beach. The petition seeks the approval of the electorate in Redondo Beach for a land use plan for the RBEP site as a mixed-use development of 600 new residences, 250 hotel rooms, and 85,000 square feet of commercial space.

On August 7, 2014, the Committee assigned to these proceedings held a status conference to discuss the impact of the initiative petition on processing the AFC. The Committee received information from AES, Energy Commission staff, Intervenor City of Redondo Beach, and the City of Hermosa Beach.¹

Based on the information received at the August 7, 2014, status conference, the Committee has revised the schedule for the proceedings and has scheduled a second status conference to discuss any new, relevant information on the initiative petition and whether the project should be suspended during the pendency of the initiative measure. This status conference will be held on September 22, 2014, at 3:00 p.m. at the Energy Commission building, 1516 9th Street, Sacramento, California.

Schedule

The attached Committee Schedule is based on the discussion at the August 7, 2014, status conference. The Committee may modify the schedule at any time upon either its own motion or that of a party. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1709.7 (c).)

Order Re: Status Reports and Status Conferences

The attached schedule continues the requirement that all parties file status reports on the first of each month. Status reports shall inform the Committee whether or not case development is progressing satisfactorily, and bring potential schedule delays and other relevant matters to the Committee's attention.

The Status Report to be filed on or about September 1, 2014, shall provide updated information on the status of the initiative petition and each party's position on whether

the proceedings should be suspended during the pendency of AES' land use ballot measure regarding the reuse of the project site for mixed use residential and commercial development.

The reports shall be **filed electronically with the Commission's Docket Unit and served no later than 3:00 p.m.** on the due date. The Commission's Docket Unit is located at 1516 Ninth Street, MS-4, Sacramento, California, 95814-5512. Status Reports must contain, "Redondo Beach Energy Project, Docket No. 12-AFC-02" in the caption or heading.

Closed Sessions

During any of the committee conferences or hearings, the Committee may, pursuant to Government Code section 11126(c)(3), temporarily adjourn the meeting to a closed session to deliberate on matters before the Committee for decision such as the case schedule, preparation of a proposed decision, motions and other matters then pending before the Committee.


