Reject Proposed HBEP

California's energy needs can be met reliably and affordably by more conservation and efficiency, energy storage and demand response, and by cleaner resources such as solar, not still more gas-fired fossil-fueled, carbon-emitting old-school plants. California is now at a crossroads. Rather than over-building fossil-fueled power plants, it is time to develop facilities, programs and procedures that support actual state carbon-reduction goals, have fewer adverse impacts, and don't saddle ratepayers with costs over decades for the wrong kind of energy. State-preferred renewable resources will create even more jobs than fossil-fueled power plants; many can actually lower energy bills, leaving more money to spend on other goods and services.
