
**Project Description:** 159 megawatt geothermal power project near Calipatria, approximately 1000 feet south of the Salton Sea in Imperial County

**Modification Description:** Petition to Extend the Deadline to Commence Construction for Black Rock 1, 2, and 3 from December 18, 2014 to December 18, 2019.

On December 10, 2014, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described extension pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under Section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code, finding that:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment;
2. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the project;
3. The project is in compliance with all laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards; and
4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.
