My name is Rudy Reyes, I was a intervenor in the Quail Brush project in Santee Ca. Being one of the few projects that was successful in defending the public land from the developer, the public comments were pivotal in defense of the case. The people came out in packs to defend their safety and lands. I see the new regulations on public comment as a way to crush public opposition and the voice of the locals. Which is against the point of the CEC and the Brown Act. The new regulations make it harder to become a intervenor and gather public support.

I also question the fact that this is the first time I have heard of these proceedings and was NOT given the opportunity to physically speak in person to this panel, I am a Burn survivor/disabled person and with fused fingers find it very hard to type...yet the public adviser has told that you no longer adhere to Americans with Disability Act and i am not allowed to talk to the board. Another major issue with the new regulations is this problem with not adhering to ADA act. which is also illegal. New regulations do NOT adhere to ADA.

With many more concerns I don't have ability to address typing, due to disabilities. I am requesting a speaking engagement with the deciding board to voice my many other concerns.
