**Project Description:** Canyon Power Project is a nominal 200 megawatt (MW) peaking power plant using four simple-cycle natural gas-fired General Electric LM 6000PC Sprint Combustion Turbine Generators.

**Modification Description:** The modification would increase the allowable usage of each of the four turbines, require additional emission reduction credits, amend the emission factor used to demonstrate compliance with the PM10 emission limits, and lower the allowable operation hours for the black start engine.

On March 11, 2015, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under Section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code.

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the project.
3. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.
