New Powerplant Would be Detremential to Redondo and Hermosa Beach

As a family with small children living within 4 blocks of the site of the proposed Redondo Beach power plant we are deeply concerned about the environmental/ health, noise, home price and other community impacts of the proposal.

--> The surrounding community includes very densely packed residential neighborhoods and it is impossible not to envision a very adverse health impact to the many families in close proximity, including those with small children such as our 2 and 4 year olds, resulting from the chemicals and airborne particulates released in the demolition of the existing plant and the regular operation of the new plant.

--> Before even considering the potential approval of a plant in such a residential neighborhood, the residents and our state leaders should demand an environmental impact study which surveys these issues as well as ground and marina contaminations associated with the construction and ongoing operation

--> The construction and operating noise will be blight on the residential neighborhoods surrounding the plant

--> The cities of Redondo Beach/ Hermosa Beach are idillic beach communities whose core appeal and property prices would be significantly impacted by a full time operating plant and the associated health/ environmental and noise impacts
