Dear Commissioners Douglas and Scott:

On May 7, 2015, the Committee for the RBEP Application for Certification issued a Revised Committee Scheduling Order. The Order indicated that the parties shall file status reports on or before the first of each month, commencing June 1, 2015, no later than 3:00 p.m. on the due date. Status reports shall inform the Committee whether or not case development is progressing satisfactorily and bring potential schedule delays and other relevant matters to the Committee's attention. The Committee further requested that the SCAQMD file status reports in the event that the timing of completion of its tasks fall outside the intervals identified in the schedule attached to the Order.

Based on the Title V Hearing requests and other comments received by SCAQMD, as well as the expressed public interest in the RBEP permitting, SCAQMD has decided to hold a separate public consultation meeting in June to receive further input from interested parties. The date, time, and location have not been finalized. SCAQMD anticipates completion of the Final Determination of Compliance (FDOC) within 30 days after the public meeting, however, the timing may change depending on the extent and contents of the air quality related comments and public input during the 30 days comment period for PSA and during the public meetings.
