Trying to get an understanding from Staff as to "penalty or no penalty" when the button is activated and if it is no penalty what is the button for? (could it be to indicate that it has a bypass duct and therefore needs a HERS verification to show on the CF1R)? And if that's the case, does staff then consider the HERS verification of the bypass, THE Penalty?
