Avenal Power Center, LLC ("Avenal") is writing to inform you that it has decided to allow the license granted by the California Energy Commission ("Energy Commission") to build and operate the Avenal Power Center project (the "Project") to expire on September 16, 2015. The San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District ("District") issued a Final Determination of Compliance for the Project on November 4, 2008 and an alternative Final Determination of Compliance for operation as a minor source on December 17, 2010 (both Final Determinations of Compliance referred to as "FDOCs"). On December 10, 2014, the Energy Commission granted Avenal additional time to evaluate the options for the Project and extended the expiration of the license from December 16, 2014 to September 16, 2015. (Order Approving a Petition to Extend the Deadline for Commencement of Construction, Order No. 14-1210-6.) The additional time granted by the Energy Commission allowed Avenal to conduct a deliberate consideration of the value of the interconnection and site location, and the current energy needs for the energy markets in California and the western states. All of the options Avenal is pursuing for the next generation of the Project differ substantially from the Project permitted by the Energy Commission in December of 2009 and analyzed by the District in both FDOCs.

Therefore, Avenal has notified the Energy Commission of its intend to allow the Energy Commission license for this Project to expire (see attached letter). Consistent with District

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policy and practice the FDOCs are only valid as long as the license is active. Thus, Avenal intends and expects that both FDOCs will expire along with the Energy Commission license on September 16, 2015.
