
**Project Description:** A combined-cycle, natural gas-fired, 520-megawatt facility was certified by the Energy Commission in its Decision on March 21, 2001, and began commercial operation in July 2003. The facility is located in the City of Blythe, in Riverside County.

**Modification Description:** The modification to the Energy Commission Decision will reduce facility-wide annual mass emissions limits for NO<sub>x</sub>, CO and PM<sub>10</sub> to reflect the current actual lower emissions, based upon source testing. With these reductions in annual emissions limits, the site will no longer be considered a major stationary source under federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration regulations.

On **July 8, 2015**, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code, finding that:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment;
2. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the project;
3. The project is in compliance with all laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards; and
4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.
