Project Description: The Procter and Gamble Cogeneration project is a 171-megawatt cogeneration facility that produces electricity and steam. The facility was certified by the Energy Commission in November 1994, and began commercial operation in March 1997. The project's simple-cycle peaking gas turbine was later added and began commercial operation in May 2001. The facility is located at 5000 83rd Street in the city of Sacramento.

Modification Description: The addition of a second boiler, Boiler 1B, and associated facilities. Existing Boiler 1B would be removed from the Campbell Soup Cogeneration facility and installed at the Procter & Gamble Cogeneration facility.

On July 8, 2015, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code, finding that:


1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment;
2. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the project;
3. The project is in compliance with all laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards; and
4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.
