ICC-Evaluation Service appreciates this opportunity to provide our comments in this proceeding, Docket #15-AAER-05 Appliance Efficiency Rulemaking for Residential Lavatory Faucets and Showerheads.

ICC-Evaluation Service is an independent third party certification organization that works with the manufacturers of plumbing products to certify products that are subject to the emergency regulations adopted by the California Energy Commission on April 8.

We urge the Commission to revise the emergency regulation adopted on April 8 to provide a July 1, 2016 manufacture deadline date for residential lavatory faucets and showerheads to be manufactured in compliance with the new standards.

Together with the provision authorizing retailers and distributors to sell-through noncompliant plumbing products, this presents a workable solution. The July 1, 2016 date is important to our company and our important role in providing product certifications. Our certification process could take approximately 4 months, and even longer if the regulation drives a tremendous volume of certification requests. There are several thousand models of residential lavatory faucets and showerheads.
