
Dear Commissioners Douglas and Scott:

On May 7, 2015, the Committee for the RBEP Application for Certification issued a Revised Committee Scheduling Order. The Order indicated that the parties shall file status reports on or before the first of each month, commencing June 1, 2015, no later than 3:00 p.m. on the due date. Status reports shall inform the Committee whether or not case development is progressing satisfactorily and bring potential schedule delays and other relevant matters to the Committee's attention. The Committee further requested that the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) file status reports in the event that the timing of completion of its tasks fall outside the intervals identified in the schedule attached to the Order.

SCAQMD staff is in the process of reviewing: (1) the revised health risk assessment incorporating the new Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment's (OEHHA) guidelines, and (2) a Southern California Edison (SCE) study that may be the study referenced by a former SCE employee to have influenced SCE to not repower at Redondo Beach. SCAQMD staff has requested AES to provide clarifying and updated information and is in the process of addressing public comments received on the Preliminary Determination of Compliance (PDOC) and at the June 25, 2015 SCAQMD Public Consultation Meeting held at the Crowne Plaza Redondo Beach & Marina Hotel. Due to the pending actions, a completion date for the Final Determination of Compliance (FDOC) has not been determined.
