Summary of the El Segundo Energy Center Petition to Amend

The modified project will be located within the existing 33-acre ESEC power plant site. The site is located at the southernmost city limit of the city of El Segundo, on the coast of the Pacific Ocean, between Dockweiler State Beach and the city of Manhattan Beach, in Los Angeles county.

ESEC L.L.C., the project owner, proposes to replace utility boiler Units 3 and 4 at the ESEC with one new combined-cycle generator (Unit 9), one new steam turbine generator (Unit 10), and two new simple-cycle gas turbines (Units 11 and 12), totaling 449 megawatts (MW). The amendment, also known as the El Segundo Power Facility Modification (ESPFM) or the ESEC amendment, proposes the demolition of Units 3 and 4, to be replaced with Units 9, 10, 11, and 12, and the replacement of a once-through seawater cooling system with dry-cooling technology.
