First of all, it is CALBO's position the any planned revision in mid-triennial cycle is a bad idea for everyone concerned and would only create confusion and frustration on the part of the applicants and jurisdictions.

Second, CALBO members believe that the more compliance options available to the stakeholders and users of the code the better. Providing more options allows for greater design flexibility while still realizing energy savings.

The planned sun-setting of a viable compliance option, mid-code cycle, does not appear to benefit the stakeholders at large.

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
