**Request for Post-Scoping Workshop Comments on  
Potential Changes to the Energy Commission's Siting Compliance  
Process and Procedure Regulations**

The Siting Lead Commissioner of the California Energy Commission, Commissioner Karen Douglas, and staff conducted a workshop on October 23, 2015, to discuss topics related to the Energy Commission's siting compliance process and procedures. The workshop initiated the process for identifying issues with the power plant licensing compliance process and discussed potential solutions. Stakeholders were, and are, encouraged to participate in this process and provide comments.

**Topics for Comments:**

- How to reduce the number of amendments or time to process amendments;
- If and when appropriate, to allow more flexibility for staff approval of project changes where applicable;
- Opportunities for streamlining and standardizing compliance processes and reporting requirements;
- Transparency of the compliance process and public participation;
- Improving the implementation of Conditions of Certification;
- Investigations; and
- Enforcement procedures.
