Staff of the California Energy Commission will introduce the new web-based version of the *A15 California Retail Fuel Outlet Annual Report*. Staff will demonstrate the website, discuss future changes to procedures, and answer questions.

Background

The Energy Commission is planning to present a new website and a web-based system for reporting A15 California retail fuel outlet annual data. The Petroleum Industry Information Reporting Act (PIIRA) requires all retail transportation fueling stations in California to file a *Retail Fuel Outlet Annual Report* (CEC-A15) to the California Energy Commission. The reports cover annual sales of gasoline, diesel, other transportation fuels, and on-site storage capacity. To complete this requirement, retailers have been filling these reports via fax, email (Excel/PDF), mail, and bulk form. A web-based system will save time for retailers by performing instant information verification and providing guidance for reports filed through this system.

Energy Commission staff will host this workshop to introduce the reporting website and provide information about its features to stakeholders. This workshop is also intended to collect feedback

for improvements and inform stakeholders about future staff procedures and processes before the website's launch in January 2016.
