PURPOSE

The purpose of the workshop is to allow staff and the project applicant to discuss outstanding data requests regarding the Palmdale Energy Project. Staff and the applicant will be prepared to discuss all remaining technical areas as necessary. An opportunity will also be provided for public comment.

Staff filed Data Requests on October 30, 2015 (Set No. 1, TN# 206472) and November 25, 2015 (Set No. 2, TN# 206777). Staff is seeking greater clarification on data requests filed for several technical issues, including those related to:

- Air Quality and Greenhouse Gasses
- Cultural Resources
- Hazardous Materials Management
- Public Health
- Socioeconomics
- Soil & Water Resources
- Transmission System Engineering
- Worker Safety & Fire Protection
- Other technical discipline discussion may also occur

NOTE: The discussion order of the above topics is *tentative*, and could change.

BACKGROUND

On April 30, 2015, the project owner, Palmdale Energy, LLC filed a Petition to Amend (PTA) with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission). The owner submitted a revised comprehensive PTA on July 17, 2015, requesting that the name of the project be changed from Palmdale Hybrid Power Project to the Palmdale Energy Project (PEP), and also to modify the technology of the facility. The PEP will be located on approximately 50 acres of land in the city of Palmdale, located in Los Angeles County, California.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The PTA requests primary modifications to the PEP to eliminate the solar component, to incorporate newer, fast start, flexible natural gas turbine technology, and to replace the water cooling tower with an air-cooled condenser (ACC). The proposed PEP would have a nominal capacity of 645 MWs. Primary equipment for the generating facility would include two natural gas-fired combustion turbine-generators (CTGs) rated at 220 MWs each, one heat recovery steam generator (HRSG), one steam turbine-generator (STG) rated at 232 MWs, and one auxiliary boiler. The plant would have a maximum overall gross output of 699.4 MWs (net) with HRSG duct burners in-service.


