### **Support for revision to clarify consumer (residential) kitchen faucets**

Elkay supports the proposed revision to the CEC's regulations that would limit the scope of kitchen faucets to consumer (residential) faucets. If this change is implemented, you should consider pushing back the implementation date back to July 1, 2016 (similar to the latest lavatory requirements) so that manufacturers can adjust to these changes and supply products that best meet the need of the markets they serve (most manufacturers, including Elkay, are probably well along in conversion).
