## **Water Treatment Chemicals**

The Hazardous Materials Division (HMD) has an existing permit with the Pio Pico Energy Center under the CalARP program. The original petition and amendment adds raw water, wastewater collection and storage tanks along with a water treatment building adjacent to the Pio Pico Energy Center. The potential impact to HMD would be that water treatment chemicals would be stored on site, and if stored in reportable quantities, would need to be reported to HMD on the Hazardous Materials Business Plan through the California Environmental Reporting System (CERS). CalARP and CERS are ministerial programs, and no additional HMD permits or permit requirements would apply.
