Dear Commissioners Douglas and Scott:

On January 14, 2016, the Committee for the Petition to Amend the Huntington Beach Energy Project (Petition) issued a Committee Scheduling Order. The Order indicated that the parties shall file status reports on or before the first of each month, commencing February 1, 2016. Status reports shall inform the Committee whether or not case development is progressing satisfactorily and bring potential schedule delays and other relevant matters to the Committee's attention. The Committee further requested that the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) file status reports in the event that the timing of completion of its tasks fall outside the intervals identified in the schedule attached to the Order.

SCAQMD staff is in the process of completing our preliminary determination of compliance (PDOC). Pending milestones include the completion of reviewing: (1) Rule 1401 health risk assessment, (2) Rules 1303/2005 criteria pollutant emissions modelling, (3) Regulation 17 Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) modelling, and (4) awaiting Federal Land Manager's determination for PSD impact analysis. In accordance with the Committee Scheduling Order, the SCAQMD is scheduled to complete the PDOC on or before April 1, 2016. Based on our progress to date the SCAQMD is ahead of target with that estimated completion time frame.
