The *2015 Integrated Energy Policy Report (2015 IEPR)* was prepared in response to the Senate Bill 1389 (Bowen, Chapter 568, Statutes of 2002) requirement that the Energy Commission adopt an integrated energy policy report every two years. The report assesses major energy trends and issues facing the state's electricity, natural gas, and transportation fuel sectors. It provides policy recommendations to conserve resources; protect the environment; ensure reliable, secure, and diverse energy supplies; enhance the state's economy; and protect public health and safety. The *2015 IEPR* was adopted by the Energy Commission at the February 10, 2016, Business Meeting.
