This is in response to SolarCity Corporation's January 15, 2016, letter requesting extension of the RPS certification application deadline for nine SolarCity facilities. Resolution 14-0422-11, adopted at the Energy Commission's April 22, 2014 Business Meeting, and incorporated in the *RPS Eligibility Guidebook, Eighth Edition*, established a process to allow the Executive Director to extend and waive application deadlines for RPS certification in certain circumstances and specified the criteria and process for requesting such extensions and waivers.

Energy Commission staff has reviewed the letter submitted by SolarCity pursuant to Resolution 14-0422-11. However, staff noted several errors and omissions in the letter.
