Attachment A states that on March 10, 2016, the Design Review Board recommended the application for approval by the City Council as submitted. The Notice states that the recommendation of the Design Review Board will be forwarded to the City Council for consideration at a future date. Also provided as Attachment B hereto are the conceptual design renderings referenced in the Notice.

As previously stated, CEC Visual Staff has had all of the information it needs to conduct a visual resources analysis of the Amended HBEP since receipt of the Petition to Amend("PTA") and Project Owner's data responses, and the enclosed information does not change that. The PTA and data responses demonstrate that the Amended HBEP will have a lesser impact on visual resources than those previously analyzed (and mitigated, where applicable) for the Licensed HBEP.

Additional information regarding the City Council's consideration of the proposed architectural screening will be provided to CEC Staff as additional information is available. As previously agreed during the December 8 Workshop, Project Owner will provide CEC Staff with visual simulations that contain architectural treatment without any landscape treatments, but only after City of Huntington Beach City Council approval of any architectural treatment plans.

- 2. The visual screening plan shall be designed to withstand the elements of the coastal environment and shall be continuously maintained by the property owner for the life of the project.


#### **INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS CONDITION:**
