The CSU would like to make the following public comment in reference to Item #5 for the CEC Business meeting on April 13th, 2016. However, I am not available to attend the meeting tomorrow and submitting the comment via email. Please advise as to the process to submit this comment into the record of tomorrow's meeting.

Honorable Commissioners:

My name is Aaron Klemm and I am the Chief of Energy and Sustainability for the California State University (CSU). CSU is a leader in high-quality, accessible and student-focused higher education with 23 campuses, 460,000 students and 47,000 faculty and staff. The Trustees of the CSU have maintained and expanded CSU's long-standing energy management program with aggressive goals for energy efficiency and carbon emissions reductions in CSU's buildings.

CSU's built environment totals over 85 million square feet with over 40% of that space being built before 1980. Consequently, cost-effective lighting alterations to existing buildings are essential for CSU to meet the Trustee's energy and climate goals given the multiple demands for limited funding and financing capacity.

CSU strongly supports the staff recommendation to approve item #5 without any amendments which will provide an additional more-cost effective compliance option for lighting alteration projects in the 2013 Building Energy Efficiency Standards. Thank you for considering this comment.
