**Subject:** ALAMITOS ENERGY CENTER (13-AFC-01) STATUS REPORT 18

On April 21, 2016 South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) informed staff that the PDOC for Alamos should be completed before the end of June 2016. To help staff expedite the development of the Air Quality and Public Health sections of the Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA), SCAQMD agreed to share with the Commission staff a preliminary internal draft of the PDOC once the first level supervisor review is complete. This draft will allow staff to begin developing the sections for Air Quality and Public Health related to the PDOC.

Staff continues to draft PSA sections and is working with the applicant and SCAQMD to meet the Committee's schedule.

## Agencies

The applicant docketed cumulative air quality information for other stationary sources near Alamos on 5/10/16. The information is under review by AQ staff.

On 5/5/16, the city of Long Beach docketed comments on the Supplemental AEC AFC suggesting architectural treatments they would like to have considered for the project.
