HUNTINGTON BEACH ENERGY PROJECT (12-AFC-02C)

On April 8, 2016, AES Southland Development, LLC, the current owner of the Huntington Beach Energy Project (HBEP) and a wholly owned subsidiary of the AES Corporation, submitted a petition to transfer ownership of the Huntington Beach Energy Project from AES Southland Development, LLC, to AES Huntington Beach Energy, LLC.

The 939-megawatt (MW) HBEP was certified by the Energy Commission on October 29, 2014. On September 4, 2015, AES Southland Development, LLC, submitted a petition to the Energy Commission to amend the Decision for Huntington Beach Energy Project. The amended project would total 844-MW, consisting of a natural gas-fired, combined-cycle, air-cooled, 644-MW electrical generating facility and two 100-MW simple-cycle gas turbines.

The petition would transfer ownership, and responsibility for compliance with the conditions of certification, from AES Southland Development to AES Huntington Beach Energy, LLC. A statement describing the change in ownership, signed under penalty of perjury by a representative of AES Huntington Beach, LLC, was submitted as required by Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769(b). The statement affirms that the new owner understands the obligations imposed by the conditions of certification and agrees to be bound by the requirements of the Energy Commission's Decision for the project. Based on the information provided, Energy Commission staff intends to recommend approval of the petition at the June 14, 2016, Business Meeting of the Energy Commission.
