# Background

On January 21, 2016, LADWP filed a Letter of Appeal<sup>2</sup> appealing the Executive Director's decision denying LADWP's Petition for Reconsideration of Energy Commission staff's denial of LADWP's Application for RPS certification for its

Scattergood, Harbor, Valley, and Haynes Generating Stations Using Biomethane from 2009 Shell and Atmos Contracts. The Energy Commission appointed the Committee to conduct hearings and other proceedings on the appeal and recommend a decision for consideration by the full Energy Commission.

#### Purpose of the Committee Status Conference

The Committee will conduct the Status Conference to assess the parties' readiness to proceed to hearings and determine an appropriate schedule for review and decision of the appeal. The Committee may also address any then-pending motions, petitions, and other requests that are ready for consideration.

As allowed by California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1205, the Status Conference may be conducted by the Hearing Officer without either Commissioner being present.

# Party Status Reports

To facilitate the discussions during the Committee Conference, the parties shall, no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, July 8, 2016, electronically file status reports containing at a minimum, the following information:

1. The *RPS Eligibility Guidebook* (Eighth Edition) states that "[a]ppeals will be considered...only upon a showing that factors other than those described in the *RPS Guidebook* were applied by the Energy Commission in denying or revoking RPS Certification."

Include a discussion of whether principles of equity or any laws would prevent or prohibit the Committee and Commission from exercising its broad authority under Public Resources Code sections 25218 and 25218.5 to consider all of the arguments presented in the Letter of Appeal, including any arguments that might not be within the scope of the above-quoted language.

- 2. Describe, without advocacy or argument, each specific area of dispute between LADWP and staff and the nature of the dispute. For disputes regarding interpretation and application of law (including statutory construction issues), identify the particular regulations and statues at issue as well as the applicable RPS Guidebook provisions, specifying the applicable edition. Also, indicate the areas of dispute for which expert witness testimony will or might be offered, including the purpose of such testimony.
- 3. A proposed schedule for this proceeding including additional Committee Status Conferences (if believed necessary), hearings, and pre- and/or post-hearing briefing.
- 4. In addition, LADWP is requested to describe any additional certification or eligibility appeals, motions, or requests that it currently expects to present to this Committee with estimated filing and review timeframes.

#### **Closed Sessions**

During the conference, the Committee may adjourn to a closed session in accordance with California Government Code section 11126, subdivision (c)(3), which allows a state body, including a delegated committee, to hold a closed session to deliberate on a decision to be reached in a proceeding the state body was required by law to conduct.
