# JASC Origins

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- How can EE most effectively reduce need for future power plants? – Senators Padilla & Fuller 2013 Legislative hearing
- Multi-agency coordination – CEC, CPUC, ISO
- Executive Oversight Committee and JASC structure
- Improve demand forecast and procurement planning processes to account for all EE
  - Forecast disaggregation
  - Increased level of confidence in future EE savings
  - Improving timing and alignment of forecast, EE funding, EM&V, and planning cycles

# Process Alignment

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- Coordinates the CEC's IEPR, CPUC's LTPP, and CAISO's TPP
- Single forecast set from CEC-adopted forecast used consistently across agency planning and procurement
- Given the required coordination between agencies under SB 350, Air Resources Board joined the Executive Oversight Committee and JASC in May 2016

# New Challenges

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- **AB 802** and **SB 350** have implications for the “single forecast set”
- **AB 802** - New baseline methods for utility programs.
  - How much utility programs savings are incremental versus already captured in codes and standards?
- **SB 350** – Doubling statewide EE savings.
  - Facilitate formulation of agency perspectives on “...to the extent cost effective, feasible and will not adversely impact public health and safety.”
  - Coordinate with economy-wide 2030 GHG goals and integrated resource planning objectives
