**Project Description:** The 158-megawatt Campbell Cogeneration Project was certified by the Energy Commission on November 30, 1994, and began commercial operation in 1997. The facility is located at 3215 47th Avenue, approximately 1 mile west of Highway 99 in Sacramento County.

**Modification Description:** Sacramento Power Authority filed a petition to amend the Campbell Cogeneration Project requesting to provide an option to replace the use of potable water with recycled water in the cooling tower when available in suitable quantities and quality; to construct additional water treatment facilities; and to increase discharge amounts to Sacramento's sanitary sewer system, resulting from the use of recycled water.

On July 13, 2016, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code, finding that:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment;
2. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the project;
3. The project is in compliance with all laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards; and
4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.
