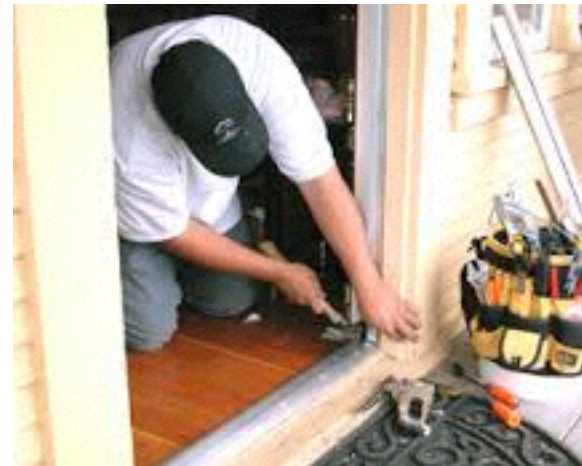

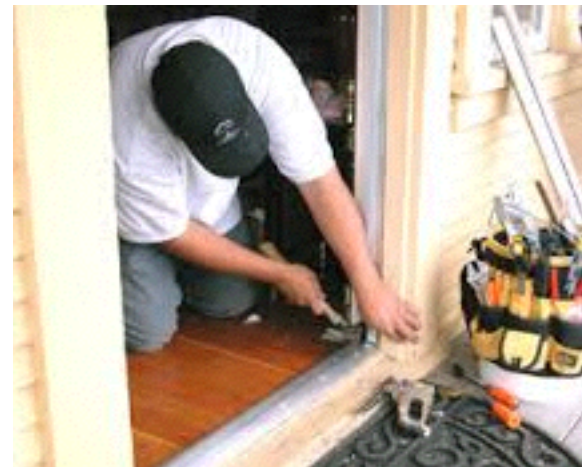

- **December:** Final study presented for adoption
- **January 1, 2017 :** Final study published and submitted to Legislature
