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## Questions Regarding the Delegate Chief Building Official Selection Process

1. Will all SOQ submissions be placed on CEC website? It is important that these SOQs which provides qualifications and past work experience not be exaggerated to influence the selection committee, this can only be assured if open to public scrutiny.
2. How many years of experience of complex - power plant code compliance will the CEC by requiring? This should be listed in the RFQ to eliminate companies with little to no experience.
3. Who will be on the Selection Committee?
4. Can one consultant company be awarded both OC and PS contracts?
5. Will power plant owners have input into the DCBO selection process for both On-Call and Project Specific?
6. Would the CEC consider increasing the SOQ number of pages to 30? This would add more detail to each company's qualifications and experience.
7. Why is the CEC not requiring a Certified Chief Building Official for this high level of service? A Combination Building Inspector lacks the Administration, Financial, Legal, Ethics, Personnel Management and Code Enforcement Certification qualities required of a Chief Building Official.
8. How will the CEC determine that a DCBO has the resources to work on multiple projects at the same time?
