Hi Andrea,

Thank you for providing links to the appropriate documents for NMFS' review. After reviewing the documents, it appears construction of the process water supply line and natural gas pipeline would require crossing Ellsworth Barranca and Todd Barranca Creeks. As a result, potential impacts to endangered steelhead and aquatic habitat from construction of the supply lines include temporary levels of increased turbidity and temp/perm impacts to riparian habitat. Construction impacts to steelhead related to the plant itself appear to be addressed correctly in the materials you provided.

With regard to process water used at the plant, please describe the frequency, magnitude, and quality of effluent to be discharged into the Santa Clara River.
