On August 10, 2016, Elyse Engel/CH2M discussed the Applicant's air quality and greenhouse gas comments on the Alamos Energy Center (AEC) Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA) with Nancy Fletcher/California Energy Commission (CEC). During this conversation, the following points were clarified:

- CH2M confirmed that the Applicant's comment letter on the AEC Preliminary Determination of Compliance (PDOC) was docketed on August 10, 2016.
- CH2M indicated that the Applicant's comment on Air Quality Table 30, regarding monthly fuel usage for the simple-cycle gas turbines, could be disregarded, as the numbers presented in the PSA were re-reviewed and found to be correct.
- CH2M indicated that the Applicant's comment on Air Quality Table 31, regarding daily and monthly emission rates for the auxiliary boiler, could be addressed by correcting the footnotes rather than by revising the numerical values themselves.
- CH2M agreed that the energy output used by CEC staff in Greenhouse Gas Table 3 is acceptable given the intent to present a more conservative estimate of performance. CH2M also agreed with CEC staff's suggestion of adding language to the table notes to clarify this conservative approach.
- CEC staff discussed other minor Applicant PSA comments. Appropriate changes will be made in the Final Staff Assessment (FSA) in response to the Applicant's comments. The proposed revisions were amenable to CH2M.
