RESOLUTION NO. 001 153

Whereas, the LADWP entered into a long-term, natural gas transportation agreement with the Kern River Gas Transmission Company (KRG T)(DWP Agreement No. 10870) on April 2, 1990, providing the LADWP with firm, natural gas interstate pipeline transportation service from various points of receipt in Wyoming to a point of delivery in California, for a 15-year term beginning on March 1, 1992, and ending on February 28, 2007, at rates approved by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC); and,

WHEREAS, on November 13, 1998, the LADWP executed a Letter of Intent with KRG T in which the LADWP indicated its interest in obtaining a 15-year TDR service from KRG T; and,

WHEREAS, on December 20, 1999, the KRG T proposed to offer firm natural gas transportation service with Term Differentiated Rates (TDR) to be incorporated through proposed TDR rate schedules for a 15-year term following FERC approval of the TDR rates beginning on or near October 1, 2001, and ending on or near September 30, 2016; and,

WHEREAS, on September 19, 2000, the Los Angeles City Council (Reference File No. 99-0283) authorized the LADWP to enter into a TDR Precedent Agreement with KRG T in which the LADWP would receive lower gas transmission rates in exchange for extending the term of its gas transportation contract with KRG T; and,

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2000, KRG T has offered to enter into an Extended Term Rate Amendment (ETRA) that provides for the final phase of implementing its Extended Term Rate program, which includes executing an ETRA as stipulated in the September 19, 2000 TDR Precedent Agreement executed by both LADWP and KRG T; and,

WHEREAS, KRG T is willing to provide, and the LADWP is willing to receive such ETRA service subject to the satisfaction of conditions specified in the TDR Precedent Agreement (DWP Agreement No. BP 99-002A; and,

BE IT RESOLVED that the ETRA (DWP Agreement No. BP 99-002B), by and between the KRG T and the LADWP, now on file with the Secretary of the Board and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, be and the same is hereby approved; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the General Manager, Assistant General Manager – Power, the Director of Generation, or the Director of Bulk Power, be and they are hereby authorized to execute the ETRA (DWP Agreement No. BP 99-002B), approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, and now on file with the Secretary of the Board, be and the same are hereby approved.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the ETRA will require the approval of the Los Angeles City Council.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Accounting Employee, upon proper certification, is authorized and directed to draw demands on the Power Revenue Fund in payment of obligations arising under this Agreement BP 99-002B.


