DOCUMENT HANDLING FOR THE FINAL STAFF ASSESSMENT PART 1 FOR THE PROPOSED ALAMITOS ENERGY CENTER (13-AFC-01)

Please make this FSA part 1 available for those who may wish to be informed about the California Energy Commission review of the application for the Alamitos Energy Center (AEC) project. We request that you not allow the Notice of Availability, the FSA part 1, or any of its contents to be removed from the library for a period of one year. To increase accessibility of the document, we ask, if possible, that you cross reference it as a general reference work under the title and author categories, as well as under such subjects as "Energy Commission," "electricity energy/generation," "power plant siting," or any other relevant subject.

The enclosed FSA part 1 contains Energy Commission staff's preliminary engineering and environmental evaluation of the proposed project. The AEC as currently proposed, would be a nominal 1,040-megawatt (MW), natural-gas-fired, combined-cycle and simple-cycle, air-cooled electrical generating facility that would be located on 21 acres on the 71-acre Alamitos Generating Station. The proposed project site, at 690 North Studebaker Road in the city of Long Beach, is bounded on the north by State Route 22, with residential areas north of State Route 22; on the east by the San Gabriel River to the south by the former Plains West Coast Terminals petroleum storage facility, and undeveloped property; and to the west by the Los Cerritos channel.

The Energy Commission's siting process is open to the public and incorporates the input of the public as well as local, state and federal agencies. To facilitate public participation in our review process, the Commission distributes copies of staff documents, such as the FSA, to public libraries in communities near the proposed project, and in major cities throughout the state. As such, please retain a copy of the enclosed Notice of Availability behind the front cover of the FSA and also post a copy of the Notice of Availability in a place conspicuous and accessible to those members of the general public who visit the library.
