Per the Committee Scheduling Order dated August 12, 2016, staff submits the following status report #2 for the Mission Rock Energy Center (Mission Rock).

DATA REQUEST SUBMISSIONS AND RESPONSES

Staff looks forward to reviewing Data Responses to Sets 1 and 1A, which applicant requested on August 22, 2016 (tn:212911) be extended 32 days, until October 3, 2016. Staff agreed with the request and reiterates its hope that the Committee adjusts the schedule, including the time for discovery, to reflect the 32-day slip in schedule resulting from the delayed submission of Data Responses to Set 1 and Set 1A.

Staff is also finalizing preparation of new data requests on biological resources, cultural resources, projection description, and visual resources that will be filed the week of October 3, 2016.

CULTURAL RESOURCES DATA REQUEST WORKSHOP

Regarding Cultural Resources, staff and applicant engaged in a public workshop on September 23, 2016 in Sacramento that resulted in mutual agreement between parties in terms of the applicant providing a draft research design for the surveying and investigating of the Project Area of Analysis (PAA). Staff reduced the initial 180 properties that constituted the PAA by eliminating certain properties based on location (within or on the edge of the PAA) and relevance. The resulting 33% reduction provided for a more acceptable survey undertaking by the applicant. Staff and applicant continue to work in a public process to best determine the best methods to identify cultural resources that may be impacted by the project.

Staff has prepared Cultural Resources Data Request No. 115 and an associated guidance document that will serve as a starting point for the research design that will ultimately define the scope of surveys to help staff determine the nature and level of impacts from the Mission Rock project. Staff plans to docket Data Request No. 115 and the guidance document on October 4, 2016.
