






2016 RTP/SCS: East West Frieght Corridor






Multi-Unit Residential




PEV Morning Peak Destinations and Workplaces

Publicly-Accessible Charging Stations (Summer/Fall 2012)



 - Over 200,000 units




Stakeholder Interviews
