COMMITTEE ORDER GRANTING PETITION TO INTERVENE

Upon consideration of the Petition to Intervene filed by Colorado River Indian Tribes (CRIT) (Petitioner), the Committee designated to conduct proceedings on the Petition to Amend the Sonoran Energy Project makes the following findings:

1. On October 4, 2016, a Petition to Intervene in the Sonoran proceeding was filed by:

Colorado River Indian Tribes
Rebecca Loudbear (Wisconsin State Bar No. 1036107)
Nancy H. Jasculca (California State Bar No. 236350)
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- 2. No deadline for filing a Petition to Intervene is currently in effect. Therefore, the Petition was timely filed. It contains the information required by California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1211.7;
- 3. No opposition to said Petition has been filed;
- 4. Intervention is granted at the Committee's discretion to the degree that it finds

intervention reasonable and relevant. The Presiding Member or Committee may impose conditions on all intervenors' participation in the hearings in order to promote the orderly conduct of the proceeding; and

5. Petitioner's interests are relevant to the above-captioned proceeding.

THEREFORE, the Committee ORDERS that the Petition to Intervene in this matter be GRANTED for the Petitioner-requested subject areas of Cultural Resources, Visual Resources, Biological Resources, Soil and Water Resources, and Geological and Paleontological Resources, and that Petitioner be placed upon the Proof of Service List as an intervenor. The Petitioner may make a motion to the Committee to participate in additional subject areas.

Petitioner may exercise the rights and shall fulfill the obligations of a party as set forth in all orders issued in this matter and California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 1212. The deadline for conducting discovery shall not be extended by the granting of this Petition. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1211.7(d).) The discovery period in this matter closed on February 3, 2016.¹
