- 2. The Petition was timely filed and contains the information required by California Code of Regulations, Title 20, section 1211.7;
- 3. No opposition to said Petition has been filed;
- 4. Intervention is granted at the Committee's discretion to the degree that it finds intervention reasonable and relevant. The Presiding Member or Committee may impose conditions on all intervenors' participation in the hearings in order to promote the orderly conduct of the proceeding; and
- 5. Petitioner's interests are relevant to the above-captioned proceeding.

**THEREFORE**, the Committee ORDERS that the Petition to Intervene in this matter be GRANTED for the Petitioner-requested subject areas of Air Quality, Public Health, Biological Resources, Soil and Water Resources, Cultural Resources, Geological and Paleontological Resources, Land Use, Greenhouse Gas Emissions, Socioeconomics, Visual Resources, Transmission System Engineering, Project Description, Project Alternatives, Facility Design, Power Plant Efficiency, Power Plant Reliability and Compliance and Closure and that Petitioner be placed upon the Proof of Service List as an intervenor. The Petitioner may make a motion to the Committee to participate in additional subject areas.

Petitioner may exercise the rights and shall fulfill the obligations of a party as set forth in all orders issued in this matter and California Code of Regulations, Title 20, section 1212. The deadlines for conducting discovery and other matters shall not be extended by the granting of this Petition. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1211.7(d).) The discovery period in this matter closed on March 7, 2016.
