## **PETITION TO CONDUCT ANY HEARINGS IN THE AFFECTED COMMUNITY**

Please provide adequate notice to the public and conduct any hearings in the affected community which experience disparate impacts in comparison to surrounding non-low-income and minority communities near the project site. The California Energy Commission (CEC) intends to proceed with a hearing regarding the proposed 844 Megawatt Huntington Beach Energy Center today DECEMBER 21, 2016 in Sacramento; not in the affected community, which is procedure improper. The Fossil fuel burning project would unnecessarily emit 1.78 million tons of GHG per year and prevent development of clean energy resources. It will also cost rate payers a billion dollars or so and adversely effect biological resources on the coast.

Ordinarily these proceedings occur in the affected community but the CEC wants to suddenly fast track the project and not bother to adequately inform the community.
