I would like to voice my concerns about the installation of Combustion Turbine Generators at the SCE Barre Substation in Stanton.

Although the notice I received stated it has emission controls it doesn't state whether the emissions will be Zero or the level of emission that will be created. My concerns as an asthmatic are will there be emissions that add to the already polluted air in this area.

My other concern is the possible installation of a 16 to 18 inch natural gas pipeline less than 500 feet from my house and the apparent long amount of time the construction will take creating more dirt and air polluting particles.

My  $3^{rd}$  concern is that if the northern route to la Palma for the pipeline is taken it will not only run within 300 feet of my house it will be in extremely close proximity to Pyle Elementary school, Dale Junior high school, Switzer Elementary school, the Buddhist church, the Greek orthodox church and the Braille institute. All of these institutions will be impacted by the construction and the very fact that extremely flammable substance will be running direct in front of their premises. In addition to these institutions there are many private residences directly on Dale and many that back up to Dale.

It is my opinion if this facility is allowed to go forward that the northern pipeline route is not only longer but impacts many intuitions and residents and should be taken off the table for further consideration.

Although I was notified because of the possible route of the pipeline, I live in Anaheim as do the residents and institutions along Dale and do not receive any services from SCE. Its true Stanton and Garden Grove are in their service area and might benefit.

I don't understand why this facility is even being considered for so heavily populated area.
