### Background

On January 21, 2016, LADWP filed a Letter of Appeal<sup>3</sup> appealing the Executive Director's decision denying LADWP's Petition for Reconsideration of Energy

Commission staff's denial of LADWP's Application for RPS certification for its Scattergood, Harbor, Valley, and Haynes Generating Stations Using Biomethane from 2009 Shell and Atmos Contracts. The Energy Commission appointed the Committee to conduct hearings and other proceedings on the appeal and recommend a decision for consideration by the full Energy Commission. On July 8, 2016, LADWP filed an additional request that the Committee consider the RPS-eligibility of specified British Columbia hydroelectric generation procurements (BC Hydro request).<sup>4</sup> The Committee granted that request on July 27, 2016.<sup>5</sup>

On January 5, 2017, the Committee released its Committee Proposed Decision<sup>6</sup> on the appeal.

# Purpose of the Committee Conference

The Committee will conduct the Committee Conference to receive party comments on the Committee Proposed Decision and discuss the scope of future activities in this proceeding. It will also address any then-pending motions or other requests that are ripe for consideration.
