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**Subject:** **Palmdale Energy Project Amendment (08-AFC-09C) STATUS UPDATE No. 15**

Since Palmdale Energy, LLC docketed their opening testimony on January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2017, nothing other than the monthly Status Update has been docketed. In addition to a request by the project owner to use updated exhibits, etc. throughout, the project owner's testimony identifies four technical areas in which they are requesting changes to staff's proposed conditions of certification; agreement exists between staff and the project owner on all remaining areas. Those four areas are Air Quality, Biological Resources, Soil and Water Resources, and Traffic and Transportation. While staff had previously agreed to the remaining dates set forth in the project owner's proposed schedule, staff awaits a Committee order to establish official deadlines.
