Eligible applicants: city, county, special district, nonprofit organization, JPAs

75% of funds available to projects located in, and that provide benefits to, disadvantaged communities (pursuant to SB 535)

Acquisition and development projects

# Eligible PROJECT examples **Urban Greening**

- Establishment, enhancement and expansion of neighborhood parks and community spaces
- Greening of public lands and structures, including school yards, and which may include incorporation of riparian habitat for water capture and provide for other public and private wildlife benefits

- Green streets and alleyways
- Non-motorized urban trails that provide safe routes for travel between residences, workplaces, commercial centers and schools
- Urban heat island mitigation and energy conservation efforts

All projects must reduce greenhouse gas emissions by including at least one of the following components:

- 1. Tree planting to sequester carbon
- 2. Tree planting to shade buildings to reduce building energy use
- 3. Constructing bicycle paths, bicycle lanes, or pedestrian facilities to reduce vehicle miles travelled.

Reduce energy consumption

Reduce car trips

Create opportunities for walking, biking, and recreating

Provide shade and cooling

Improve air and water quality

Capture stormwater

Create habitat
