PRINCIPAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Establish a coordinating task force
2. Enable the economic advantages for community solar
3. Strategize on effective green workforce and education goals in disadvantaged communities
4. Continue developing a series of energy upgrade financing pilot programs
5. Collaboration to establish common metrics and collect and use data systematically across programs

- 6. Expand opportunities for renewable energy**
- 7. Enhance affordable housing tax credits/credit enhancements supporting clean energy upgrades**
