Funding for low GWP Refrigerant solutions for Grocery Stores

In addition to the obvious environmental benefits of low GWP refrigerants, systems employing low GWP refrigerants, particularly natural refrigerants, have demonstrated significant energy reduction benefits. Europe is somewhat ahead of the United States for market penetration of such systems largely in part to a long and visible roadmap on F-Gas Phasedown. For Europe, this has meant a cost parity point to higher GWP systems being realised due to the volume transition to lower GWP systems in recent years. The US remains in an infancy stage for low GWP systems and they continue to attract a premium in upfront cost, an early adoption incentive programme would help both the end user bridge the investment gap and assist the CEC in starting to make a reduction in the energy profiles of grocery stores for what is not an unlimited resource
