This letter is in response to your March 30, 2017, written request to extend the filing deadline for the *2017 Integrated Energy Policy Report (2017 IEPR)* Electricity Demand Forecast and Supply Forecast forms.

The Energy Commission understands that San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) is in the process of developing new forecasting models that will enable a more detailed end-use level analyses for the *2017 IEPR*. The Energy Commission also understands that due to delays in the new process, SDG&E is seeking an eighteen-day extension from April 17, 2017 to May 5, 2017 for submitting Electricity Demand Forecast forms and a twenty-one-day extension from April 28, 2017 to May 19, 2017 for submitting Supply Forecast forms.

According to forms and instructions that were adopted by the Energy Commission on December 14, 2016, the information submitted by SDG&E helps clarify its view of electricity demand trends and planning assessments as part of the analysis for the *2017 IEPR*.

I find that good cause exists for the above-described extension requests by SDG&E. In accordance with Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1342(c), I grant the request for extending the deadline to submit the Electricity Demand Forecast forms and Supply Forecast forms.

I appreciate that SDG&E wants to submit data of the highest quality. I look forward to SDG&E staff's results for the *2017 IEPR* proceeding.
