Mr. Levine explained his position that the British Columbia Hydroelectric generation should be grandfathered into qualifying status for RPS Compliance Period No. 1. He subsequently filed a letter summarizing his statements (TN 217488, filed May 8, 2017). We refer you to that document for further details.

Commission staff made brief remarks in response to Mr. Levine's comments. LADWP representatives and staff discussed their respective positions both while the Committee was present and during the Committee's closed session. At the conclusion of those discussions, Mr. Levine reported his conclusion that it was unlikely that the parties would be able to settle their differences.

Public comment was solicited. No public comment was received.

The Committee adjourned into closed session to deliberate. On its return from closed session the Committee reported that it was continuing the Committee Conference to 3:00 pm on Wednesday, May 10, 2017 for the primary purpose of further deliberating in closed session.
