Background

During February 7-10, 2017, the Committee held public evidentiary hearings in Oxnard, California, on the Application, which proposes a 262 megawatt natural-gas-fired, simple cycle electrical generating facility. The Proposed Project would be built on

approximately three acres within the existing 36-acre Mandalay Generating Station site at 393 North Harbor Boulevard, Oxnard.

On March 10, 2017, the Committee issued *Orders for Additional Evidence and Briefing Following Evidentiary Hearings*,² which, among other things, ordered the Applicant and Energy Commission Staff (Staff) to submit additional evidence regarding specified subtopics related to biological resources, coastal flooding, the effects of smaller turbine(s) on aviation at alternative sites, and the Proposed Project's eventual closure. All other parties were invited to submit additional evidence on these topics. On April 27, 2017, Intevenor City of Oxnard filed 13 separate documents titled as the "Supplemental Testimony of James H. Caldwell."

The Committee subsequently issued a revised scheduling order for this proceeding on May 11, 2017.⁴ That same day, the Applicant filed a motion (the Applicant's motion) to exclude Mr. Caldwell's supplemental testimony from the evidence on the grounds that the testimony is outside the scope of supplemental testimony described in the Committee's March 10 orders.⁵

Party responses to the Applicant's Motion are due on May 25, 2017.

On May 22, 2017, Staff filed a memorandum⁶ reporting on discussions before the California Independent System Operator's (California ISO) Board of Governors on May 1, 2017, initiated by public comments made by James H. Caldwell on behalf of the Center for Energy Efficiency and Renewable Technologies (CEERT) and City of Oxnard, about whether the Proposed Project is the appropriate project to meet energy needs in the Moorpark area. The supplemental testimony of Mr. Caldwell relates to that question as well.

Purpose of the Committee Conference

The purpose of the Committee Conference is to allow the Committee, the parties, and the public the opportunity to discuss the status of the proceeding, the relevance of the May 1 California ISO discussion, and consider the Applicant's motion. The Committee may also address any then-pending motions, petitions, or other requests that are ready for consideration.

Closed Session Deliberations

At any time during the Committee Conference, the Committee may adjourn to a closed session in accordance with California Government Code section 11126, subdivision (c)(3), which allows a state body, including a delegated committee, to hold a closed

session to deliberate on a decision to be reached in a proceeding the state body was required by law to conduct.
